

Atherton Aero Club - Advanced Pilot Proficiency Program

Members may recall that a few years back our club applied for and received a grant as part of a CASA Safety Promotion being conducted at the time. The purpose of the grant was to assist the club in developing a program to help club members maintain their flying proficiency and also to motivate the participants to improve their flying skills above those basic requirements.

Accordingly, and to that end, a series of flying exercises were designed for use as practice pieces. Pilot members were involved in trialing the exercises and provided excellent feedback and practical suggestions that helped us to iron out the initial shortcomings.

Work progressed to the stage where, following a number of revisions, five Units containing a total of 28 Exercises plus additional Supporting documents were finalized. Following that, and for a number of reasons, those involved needed to take a break from the program to attend to other commitments. The completed Units are as follows:-

Unit 1 - Straight & Level (5 Exercises)

Unit 2 - Level Turns (8 Exercises)

Unit 2A - Combined Straight & Level and Level Turns (2 Exercises)

Unit 3 - Climb, Descent, Climbing & Descending Turns (8 Exercises)

Unit 4 - Steep Level Turns (2 Exercises)

Unit 5 - Steep Descending Turns (3 Exercises)

Another five Units are awaiting completion.

The five completed Units are now available for members to download from the Atherton Aero Club website. Those interested in doing so please contact me for the necessary **link and password** and to arrange for a **briefing** on the workings of the program.

Password protection allows us to keep track of who is using the program. It is also an acknowledgement by users that the program is the property of the Atherton Aero Club.

It is appropriate that AAC members should have first go at the exercises so initially access to the material is only being made available to club members. Others will eventually be able to access the program but only after AAC members have had an opportunity to assess and comment on its contents. The Exercises completed to date should be considered as a Work In Progress. Further refinements can be expected as experience is gained with the program.

A Brief History of the FNQAM Dakota A65-73

The FNQAMs beloved Douglas C-47 Dakota turns 80 this month (February 2025).

This remarkable aircraft has a rich history—from its service in World War II and post-war duties to its later role as a movie star in The Thin Red Line. Now, it's legacy will be honored with a small gathering of aviation enthusiasts, history buffs, and friends on Saturday 15th February, 2025 at the FNQA Mareeba museum site.

History of the FNQAM Dakota A65-73 (Continued)

A65-73 was constructed under a USAAF contract (AC535-AC-2032) and was the fourth of ten C-47Bs produced in its batch (Case 573, Indent 2415). Originally designated 44-76339, it was delivered to the Royal Australian Air Force (RAAF) in February 1945.

Wartime Service Delivered to the RAAF as Dakota A65-73 in February 1945, the aircraft was assigned to 3 Air Depot (3 AD) on 27 February. Shortly thereafter, on 3 March 1945, it was transferred to 37 Squadron with the call sign VH-CIP and fuselage code OM-P. It later became part of 86 Wing.

Postwar Service A65-73 played a role in the 1946 Australian film The Overlanders. On 14 March 1947, it was transferred to the Department of Aircraft Production (DAP), and on 25 August 1947, it moved to 1 Air Depot (1 AD). Around this time, it was stripped to a bare aluminium finish with "No. 86 Transport Wing" painted above the fuselage windows, a centre stripe along the fuselage, and the RAAF logo on the nose. It returned to 86 Wing on 5 September 1947.

Between 1948 and the early 1960s, A65-73 was frequently reassigned between units, including Central Flying School (CFS), 90 Wing, 25 Squadron, and various Air Depots. The aircraft suffered several incidents, including an accident at East Sale Airfield in 1950 and hailstorm damage in 1952. Despite these setbacks, it remained in service, undergoing repairs and modifications as needed.

In the 1960s, the Dakota continued to serve in various capacities, including assignments with Base Squadron at RAAF Darwin and 2 Squadron at RAAF Butterworth. In 1967, it was modified at Bankstown Airfield for TACAN calibration installation before being assigned to 10 MR Squadron in 1969.

On 5 September 1971, A65-73 was damaged beyond repair while landing at RAAF Townsville. It was officially stricken from RAAF service on 10 October 1973 and subsequently disposed of to the public.

Later Years and Display The aircraft was acquired by Sid Beck and placed on outdoor display at The Beck Museum. In the late 1990s, it was repainted in the markings of C-47-DL Dakota "13866" with olive drab upper surfaces and grey lower surfaces for its role in the Hollywood film The Thin Red Line (1998). By mid-2007, it had been repainted in silver.

A65-73 remains a testament to the enduring legacy of the Dakota aircraft in Australian military and aviation history.


