


The next **AAC Club Meeting** will be our monthly get together on **Sunday the 16th of October 2022** starting at **10:30am**.










Also, Thank you to the volunteers who helped out today, to run the breakfast BBQ and flag off the competitors.








NORTH QUEENSLAND AERO CLUB NEWS & EVENTS



Introducing Mareeba Airport's latest addition - the 80th anniversary mural at the airport terminal! Daniel Wallwork has done an incredible job capturing the airport's contribution and identity over the last 8 decades. This includes RAAF Dakota C-47s during WWII, crop spraying, helicopter mustering & hot air ballooning.

This project was managed by FNQAM and supported by the Regional Arts Development Fund (RADF) - a partnership between the Queensland Government and Mareeba Shire Council to support local arts and culture in regional Queensland.

Filming for our short film was conducted a few weeks ago and production is nearing closer to finalisation in the coming weeks! Thanks to everyone who was involved with this project and we look forward to sharing the finished product with you.

There's been plenty of activity happening on Saturday mornings with the installation of the Dakota tail fin, C-47 stairs being fabricated, manuals and magazines digitised, books catalogued & new instrument panels arriving. 




