Venue the AAC Atherton Aerodrome storage facility.







HOT AND HIGH - YATN 17 JAN 2022



Crank up the numbers: Field Elevation 2460 feet, QNH 1006, Temperature 33° C.

Pressure Height - $(1013-1006 = 7 \times 30ft = +210ft) 2460 + 210 = 2670 feet PH$

Density Height - ISA Temp at 2670 is 10°C, the Actual Temp of 33°C is 23° above ISA,

23 x 120ft per degree above ISA = +2760ft. PH 2670 + 2760 = **5430 feet DH**

Accident Probe: Course Reversal In IMC

It's a maneuver the VFR-only pilot should practice, but probably doesn't. By Joseph E. (Jeb) Burnside, AVweb February 7, 2022

We've long maintained that one of the best ways for a pilot to enhance his or her aviation risk management is to earn and use the instrument rating. This is especially true if the pilot in question has plans to use their pilot certificate for transportation on anything resembling a schedule. That's because the skills, knowledge and experience gained by earning the rating simply help make any flight beyond an airport's immediate environs more predictable and less risky.





BUILDERS CORNER 1 - Extracts from Jon Collins' Skybolt Blog

February 6th - Some steady progress on the Skybolt over the past few months. Finished ribstitching the tail surfaces. They are now ready for priming.

Did some planning on the firewall for the various electrical and plumbing components. Made some steel brackets for throttle/mixture fitting and prop control.

Also spent a month reorganising the workshop to create room for a spray booth which will be needed soon.

Had to make a fuselage rotisserie to help with the fabrication of the aluminium fuselage panels forward of the rear cockpit.

It will also be used for covering and painting the rear fuselage. Each photo has further details. Steady progress but the end is in sight!






