





Miami Accident - Don't Be Fearful of Ditching AVweb 16th May 2022



Over the weekend of May 14th, a Cessna 172 made an emergency landing on the Haulover Inlet Bridge, resulting on one fatality. Ditching in the water might have been the higher percentage choice. In this video, Paul Bertorelli goes over the numbers. If you keep them in mind, it might help you overcome fear of ditching if it ever turns out to be the better survival choice.



It includes an introductory GFA membership and approximately 20 minutes worth of flying with an instructor. Additional launches and flying at club rates.



Donnington Airpark has secured fuel sponsorship from local businesses and private individuals to cover the cost of ferry fuel required to get both aircraft to Woodstock.


